Parking

Please note that parking is limited at LCIS. We encourage all conference delegates to use public transportation and / or carpool if possible.

Registration

Registration will take place just inside the main entrance at La Côte International School as of 8h00. Please sign-in and collect your badge. Your badge **must** be visible at all times when you are in the building. If you are attending the Gala dinner at the Olympic Museum on Friday evening, there will be a cloakroom ticket inside your badge. This ticket has a specific number and will be used for your entrance to the Gala dinner as well as for raffle prizes.

Cloakroom
